Annual Security Reports must comply with the new requirements by October 1, 2014

Recent amendments to the **Clery Act** require institutions to compile statistics for incidents of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking and to include **certain policies, procedures, and programs** pertaining to these incidents in the **Annual Security Reports (ASRs)**. The statute requires institutions to include this new information in the ASR that must be provided to students, employees, and prospective students and prospective employees by **October 1, 2014**.

Until final regulations are published and effective, institutions must make a good-faith effort to comply with the statutory provisions as written. Join us for a 90-minute training on how to **bring your institution's ASR into compliance**.
