

Campus SaVE Act Final Regulations Update

Earlier this week, the Department of Education issued **final regulations implementing the Campus SaVE Act** amendments to the Clery Act. Campus SaVE and the final rule are intended to require institutions to more effectively **address, and ultimately reduce, sexual violence on college campuses**, including domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking.

The newly published rule details additional requirements to ensure that institutions **provide more complete information** to their students, better **inform and protect** victims, and **clarify the process** for collecting and reporting crime statistics in annual security reports, including incidents that were investigated and determined to be unfounded.
